Discounts and Subsidies

Participants who hold a valid Trail Running Association of the Republic of China (TTRA) membership are eligible for a NT\$400 subsidy for any race category (limited to one time per member).

Subsidy Collection Method

- **On event day:** Collect the NT\$400 subsidy in person
- **Post-event bank transfer:**
 - Email an application within one week after the event to ttra.taiwan@gmail.com
 - Include the following information:
 - Full name
 - National ID number
 - Bib number
 - Copy of bankbook cover
 - After deducting bank transfer fees, the subsidy will be transferred to the designated account within **30 days**

Group Registration Policy

- Group registrations are eligible for early bird pricing
- Minimum 10 participants required for group registration
- Groups of 30 participants will receive one dedicated team tent (maximum of 10 tents available)
- Group registrations are not eligible for the TTRA member subsidy
- Members wishing to receive the subsidy must register individually

Elite Athlete Registration Channel

Domestic Elite Athlete Criteria

- Men: ITRA Index 680 or above – registration fee waived
- Women: ITRA Index 560 or above – registration fee waived

International Elite Athlete Criteria

- Men: ITRA Index 730 or above – registration fee waived
- Women: ITRA Index 590 or above – registration fee waived

Additional Notes

1. Top 3 overall finishers will receive free entry to the next edition of the event (non-transferable)
2. Elite athletes must apply by emailing ttra.taiwan@gmail.com
3. Foreign nationals holding Taiwan Permanent Residency (APRC) must submit a copy of their APRC card to enjoy the same benefits as domestic elite athletes. Any other long term proof will be reviewed.

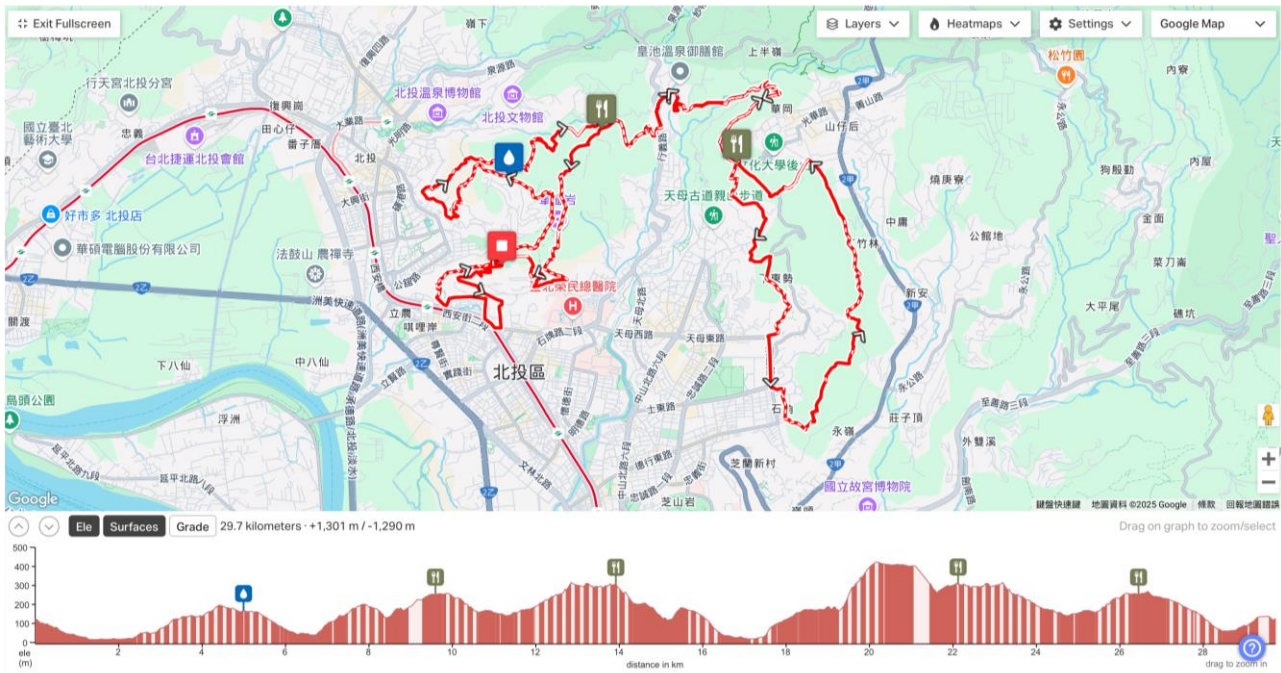

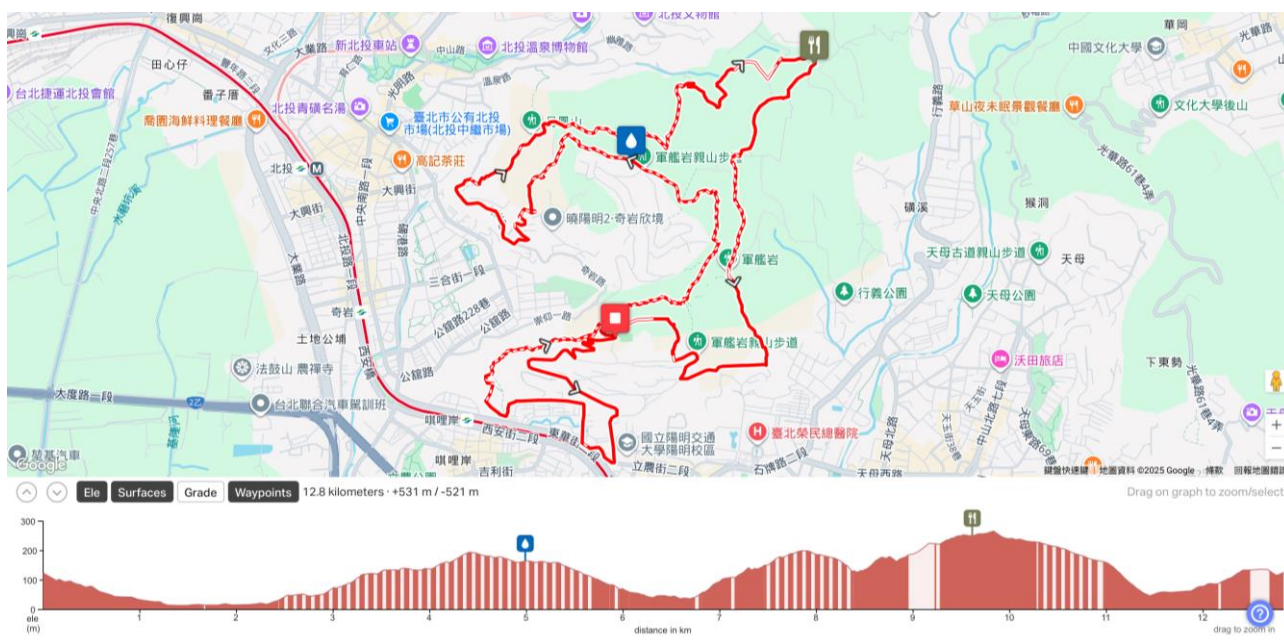

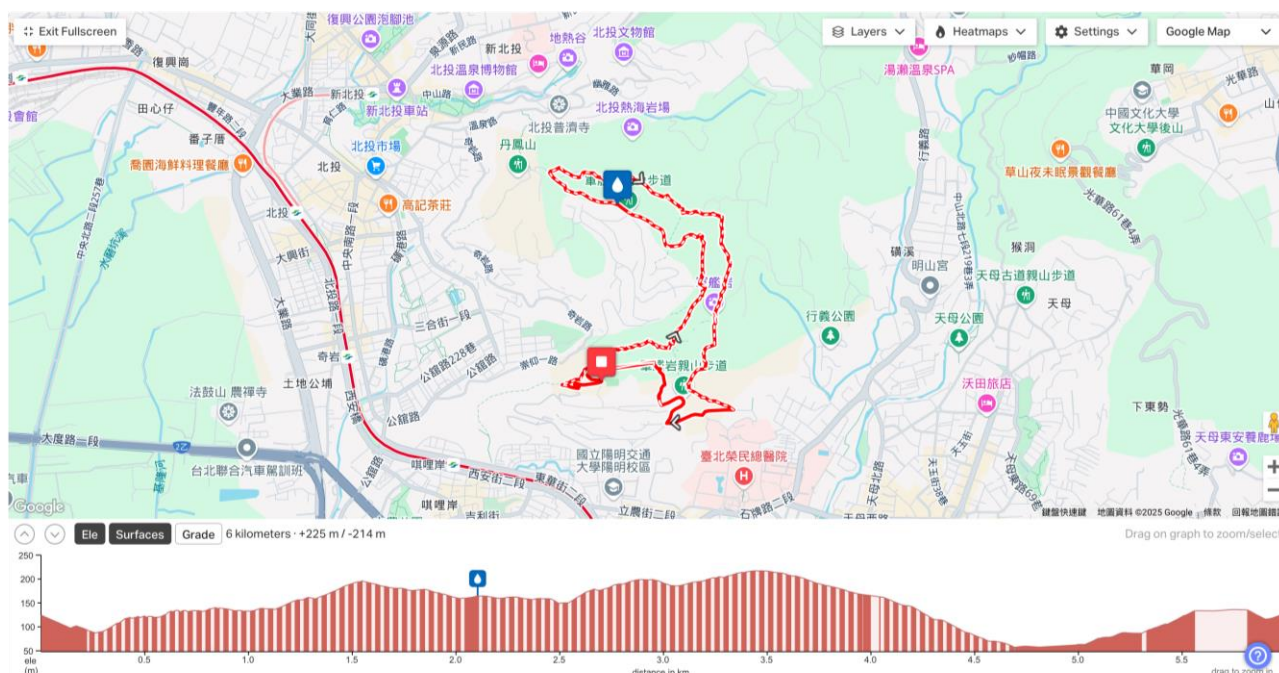

Refund Policy

1. Before the registration deadline:
Participants who apply for cancellation and refund before the registration deadline will be refunded according to the registration platform's refund policy.
2. Before the registration deadline (administrative fee applies):
A NT\$100 administrative and bank handling fee will be deducted, and the remaining balance will be refunded.
3. After the registration deadline:
As customized race materials will already be in production, no refunds will be accepted after the registration deadline, except under the circumstances listed below.
Participants who are unable to attend due to the following reasons may apply for a refund by providing valid supporting documents. 50% of the registration fee will be deducted, and the remaining balance will be refunded.

Eligible reasons include:

- Natural or man-made disasters
 - Transportation disruption
 - Military service, reserve duty, or official training call-up
 - Injury, illness, or pregnancy
 - Death of a spouse or first-degree family member
 - Other circumstances approved by the organizer
4. Refund applicants must provide the following information:
 - Participant name

- Race category
 - Bank account details
 - Copy of bankbook cover
- Please email all documents to ttra.taiwan@gmail.com
5. Approved refunds will be transferred to the designated account within one month after the event.

Important Notes

I. Start Groups & Safety Declaration

1. Wave Starts

- Due to narrow trails and steep sections, wave starts will be implemented to prevent congestion and accidents.
- Participants must start strictly according to their assigned time slot. Early or late starts will be considered Did Not Finish (DNF) and will not be ranked or receive an official result certificate.
(Finishers will still receive a finisher medal and event gifts.)

2. Personal Health Assessment

- The course is technically demanding. Participants must assess their own physical condition and fitness level.
- If discomfort occurs during the race, participants should stop immediately and notify race officials or volunteers for assistance.

3. Liability Disclaimer

- By registering, participants agree that the organizer bears no legal or financial responsibility for accidents, injuries, or fatalities caused by personal illness, physical conditions, failure to follow race rules, or non-compliance with officials' instructions.

4. Insurance Coverage

- All participants are covered by Travel Accident Insurance provided by the organizer:
 - Accident death and disability coverage: NT\$1,000,000
- Conditions arising from pre-existing illnesses are not covered.
- Insurance coverage details are subject to the insurance policy terms. Participants requiring additional coverage must arrange it independently.

5. Weather & Force Majeure

- The event will proceed rain or shine.
- In the event of a sea or land typhoon warning or other natural disasters, the organizer reserves the right to cancel, postpone, modify the course, or end the event early to ensure participant safety.

II. Course Regulations & Timing Chip Management

1. Timing Chips & Results

- Exchanging chips, carrying another participant's chip, or carrying multiple chips is strictly prohibited. Violators will have their chip confiscated and results voided.
- Participants who do not start within 20 minutes after the official start time may be prohibited from starting for safety reasons and will not receive a result.
- Participants are responsible for ensuring their chip is securely worn. No results will be issued for lost chips or missed timing checkpoints.

2. Turnaround Points

- All turnaround points must be recorded by timing chip.
- Failure to record or provide valid proof will be considered withdrawal, and no result will be issued.

3. Bib Number Rules

- Bib numbers must remain intact and clearly visible at all times.
- If a bib cannot be identified, officials may prohibit the participant from entering the final 30 meters before the finish line.

4. Officials' Authority & Fair Play

- Any behavior obstructing other participants or disobeying officials' instructions is prohibited and may result in disqualification.
- Receiving external assistance such as vehicles or physical support to gain an advantage is strictly forbidden.
- Violators will have their results voided, be banned from the event for one year, and have their names published on the official website.

5. Identity & Eligibility

- Participants must compete in the category matching their registered identity.
- Impersonation, substitute running, or transferring entries is strictly prohibited and will result in disqualification.

III. Additional Regulations

1. Media & Image Rights

- By registering, participants agree that the organizer may use photos, videos, and participant data for promotional purposes.
- Participants who do not agree should **not register**.

2. Health Restrictions

- Individuals with cardiovascular disease, diabetes, or other conditions unsuitable for prolonged intense exercise are prohibited from participating.
- Concealing medical conditions that result in accidents is the participant's own responsibility.

3. Event Information Updates

- Any updates or changes to these regulations will be announced on the official Taiwan Trail Running Association fan page.
- Participants are responsible for staying informed.

4. Safety Plan & Insurance Provider

- Public liability insurance is provided by Hotai Insurance Co., Ltd.
- Travel accident insurance coverage includes:
 - Accident death and disability: NT\$1,000,000
 - Accident medical reimbursement: up to NT\$100,000

5. Results & Final Authority

- Final rankings are based on official race results.
- The Chief Referee has final authority on all results and rulings.
